Stop 1: Cultural Tastes at Ziibiwing Cultural Center

Following the tour, head over to Cup of Joy to enjoy a sampling of traditional Native foods such as fry bread or seasonal specialties while learning about the cultural significance of Indigenous culinary traditions.

Stop 2: Craft Brewing at Summit Smokehouse

Take a behind-the-scenes brewery tour of how Mountain Town's famous beer is made.

Guests enjoy guided tasting flights of handcrafted beers while learning about the brewing process and the role craft beverages play in Michigan's culture.

Stop 3: Elevated Flavors at Wood Shop Social

Experience modern American cuisine at Wood Shop Social.

Groups can enjoy a curated small-plate tasting featuring chef-driven creations, seasonal ingredients, and signature cocktails or bourbon sampling.

Stop 4: Sweet Treats & Downtown Discoveries

Head into historic downtown Mount Pleasant for a sweet finale.
